

Undergraduate Exchange Information:

All classes are in Portuguese

USP is a public University and doesn't charge tuition from students

Exchange period: 1 or 2 semesters

USP offers in-person Portuguese courses to exchange students (limited places)

Interships aren't allowed to exchange students

USP Ifriends–Buddy Program for exchange students

1st academic semester: March-June 2023

2nd academic semester: August-November 2023



Undergraduate Exchange Information:

1 USP credit = 15 hours of class work

Grades range from 0,0 (zero) to 10,0 (ten)

To pass a course, students must fulfill 2 conditions: minimum score of 5,0 (five) and minimum attendance of 70%

Exchange students have 2-3 weeks at the beginning of the semester to make changes to their study plans

Exchange students can choose disciplines from different courses at USP

License and Master 1 students can only take disciplines from undergrad courses

Master 2 students can take disciplines from undergrad and from grad courses
