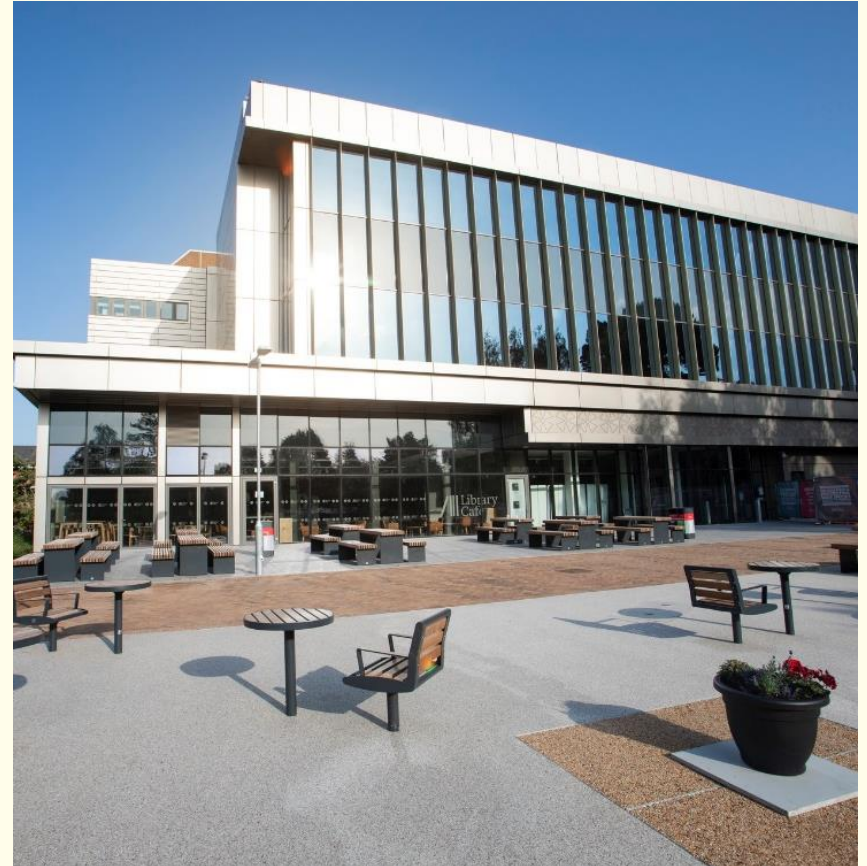
Location
